FY24 Pilot Parking Program

The goals of the pilot plan are to:

- gather data needed for a robust and fiscally sound pricing plan,
- ensure employees making below \$70k have a lower cost option (2/3 of college staff),
- ensure employees who have not paid for parking for several years have both plenty of notice about the plan and have a free option,
- start to reduce the inequity in the cost of the various commuter passes,
- provide a mechanism for donors and special guests to have free parking when needed, and
- hopefully have a relatively revenue neutral pilot year.



FY24 Pilot Parking Program – Key Provisions

Free Parking – Pass Required – All 500 series lots

- Parking pass requirement will be enforced!
 Salary up to \$70k 10% discount on all pass types
 Salary \$70k and higher no change in pass pricing
 Commuter passes student pass increasing 3.6%
 - matches housing increase and is less than Boulder's 4% increase

Hourly parking in 500 series lots –

\$1.25 per hour M-Th – 8am – 4pm
\$0.75 per hour M-Th – 4pm – 10pm
Free for those registering for a parking pass
Free on Fridays and weekends
